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In the News

- U.S. Pain Foundation former CEO pleaded guilty to wire fraud, tax evasion in & misappropriation of funds. He resigned May 2018.
- Hasting's Report addresses America's <u>draconian approach to opioid laws</u> add <u>stigma without care</u> improvement.
- AMA report calls out the need for lawmakers end the opioid epidemic by removing, not adding barriers to care.
- The World Health Organization's new classification system includes a <u>new ICD-11 diagnostic code for chronic pain</u> as disease.
- FDA approved (Theranica) a prescription smartphone app for acute migraine that regulates electrical stimuli to upper arm.
- Five <u>drug companies pay millions to settle state & federal lawsuits</u> accusing them of helping to fuel the opioid epidemic.
- FDA wants your opinion on their proposed requirement for blister packs with 5, 10 or 15 opioid tablets for new patients with acute pain.
- Senator Alexander speaks out about the "pain crisis" with patients unable to access proper care; calling for changes in pain treatment.
- Cannabidiol (CBD) for pain can't be marketed despite legal changes. The FDA wants to know more about cannabinoids to inform policy.
- H.H.S. Pain Management Best Practices Inter-Agency Task Force Report identifies gaps and key opportunities for improvement.
- Ohio doctor is formally charged with 25 counts of murder after allegedly ordering fatal doses of opioids for over two dozen patients.

- Sebbag E, Felten R, Sagez F, et al. The world-wide burden of musculoskeletal diseases: a systematic analysis of the World Health
 Organization Burden of Diseases Database. Ann Rheum Dis. 2019 Jun;78(6):844-8. Rates of disability and premature death from
 musculoskeletal diseases have increased substantially increased since 2000, making them the second leading cause of disability.
- Frey DP, Bauer ME, Bell CL, et al. <u>Virtual Reality Analgesia in Labor</u>: The VRAIL Pilot Study-a preliminary randomized controlled trial suggesting benefit of immersive virtual reality analgesia in unmedicated laboring women. *Anesth Analg.* 2019 Jun;128(6):e93-e96. Virtual Reality during the first stage of labor significantly reduced sensory, affective & evaluative pain as well as anxiety in unmedicated women.
- Griffioen MA, Ziegler ML, O'Toole RV, et al. Change in pain score after administration of <u>analgesics for lower extremity fracture pain</u> during hospitalization. *Pain Manag Nurs*. 2019 Apr;20(2):158-63. Most single analgesics (monotherapy) don't provide 50% relief after leg fracture.
- Vaughn IA, Terry EL, Bartley EJ, et al. Racial-ethnic differences in osteoarthritis pain and disability: a meta-analysis. *J Pain*. 2019 Jun;20 (6):629-44. Over 200 studies support African Americans have more severe arthritis pain & related disability than other racial/ethnic groups.
- Rigoard P, Basu S, Desai M, et al. Multicolumn spinal cord stimulation for predominant back pain in failed back surgery syndrome patients: a multicenter randomized controlled trial. *Pain*. 2019 Jun;160(6):1410-20. Spinal cord stimulation improves pain & functioning better than optimal medical management, but 12% of those studied needed surgical reintervention. Improvements were sustained at least 1-2 years.
- Ko SY, Leung DY, Wong EM. Effects of <u>easy listening music intervention</u> on satisfaction, anxiety, and pain in patients undergoing colonoscopy: a pilot randomized controlled trial. *Clin Interv Aging*. 2019 May 28;14:977-986. MP3-music improved pain & satisfaction.

- Mauck MC, Hu J, Sefton C, et al. Obesity increases the risk of chronic pain development following motor vehicle collision. *Pain*. 2019;
 160(3):670-675. Morbid obesity increases risk chronic pain after a car accident by 40%, which may be linked to a shared genetic variant.
- Mercadante S, Adile C, Masedu F, et al. Breakthrough cancer pain in patients with abdominal visceral cancer pain. *J Pain Symptom Manage*. 2019 May;57(5):966-70. Visceral breakthrough pain is common with abdominal cancer, severe & often striking within minutes of trying to eat.
- Smothers ZPW. The experience of a pain patient. *Anesthesiology*. 2019; Jul;131(1):211-2. Balancing the medical & humanistic side of pain from a herniated disc. A medical student shares insights of primary care and specialty physicians ignoring reports of pain, delaying diagnosis.
- Bazika-Gerasch B, Maier C, Kumowski, et al. Compared to limb pain of other origin, ultrasonographic osteodensitometry reveals loss of bone density in complex regional pain syndrome. Pain. 2019 Jun;160(6):1261-69. CRPS decreases bone density, different from osteoporosis.
- Barkai O, Puig S, et al. Platelet-derived growth factor activates nociceptive neurons by inhibiting M-current and contributes to inflammatory pain. Pain. 2019 Jun;160(6):1281-96. A new pain-facilitating proinflammatory mediator is discovered; a possible target for new treatments.
- Trost MJ, Ford AR, Kysh L, et al. Socially assistive <u>robots for helping pediatric distress and pain</u>: a review of current evidence and recommendations for future research and practice. Clin J Pain. 2019; May;35(5):451-8. Current robots help children cut distress, not pain.

- New website promotes evidence-based solutions to pediatric pain through coordination & collaboration has English & French resources.
- ASPMN gets The Joint Commission clarification on prn analgesic orders and pain standards; debunking myths & misconceptions.
- ACOG Guideline addresses harm of untreated postpartum pain with a balanced perspective of opioid risks & benefits after delivery.
- Pain in people with cognitive impairments, intellectual disabilities or psychiatric disorders require individualized assessment & treatment
- NIOSH has a multipronged approach to the opioid crisis by identifying personal/workplace risks while protecting workers & responders.

Complementary Integrative Health

- A <u>smartphone progressive muscle relaxation App</u> was adopted by approximately half of patients with migraine offered this intervention.
- <u>Virtual reality effectively reduces pediatric procedural pain</u> & anxiety by distraction, but research on benefits for other pain types is limited.
- At 12-16 breaths per minute, <u>rhythmic slow breathing reduces pain unpleasantness</u> with effects similar to mindfulness meditation.
- Repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation is a promising approach to cut headache frequency, duration, intensity, medication use.
- Mindfulness-based stress reduction (MBSR) improves pain, distress & functioning similar to cognitive-behavioral therapy for chronic pain.
- Consuming 40 grams freeze-dried blueberry powder improved pain, functioning, inflammation & cartilage metabolism for knee arthritis.
- A high-frequency transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation (Quell) reduced chronic low back pain, disability and catastrophizing.
